CORBEL

Corbels have a recessed keyhole plate allowing for each to be easily hung flush to a wall. Each corbel comes complete with installation hardware and is sanded smooth, ready to finish.

For Installing as Shelf Corbel

- 1) Place corbel on the wall so that the screw hole will be in the center of a wall stud. Mark shelf location on the wall.
- 2) Place the hole 2" below the desired height of the shelf. Drill 1/8" hole to a depth of 2". Insert enclosed screw and leave 1/4" of it sticking out from the wall.
- 3) Hook the corbel over the screw head and push the corbel down into the locking position.
- 4) The corbel will be loose if the screw is out too far from the wall. If this occurs, tighten screw ½ turn and try again. Repeat until corbel is tight against the wall.
- 5) If the corbel cannot be positioned over the screw head, loosen screw ½ turn and try mounting the corbel again. Repeat until corbel slides down over the screw head.

For Installing Under Countertop

- Install using nails, screws and/or glue.
- When installing, it is recommended that the fasteners hit the cabinet framework.
