


Insert Cam Locks (B) into holes on Cross Bars (7).

Attach Cross Bars (7) to Right Side Panel (4) and Divider Panel (6) using Cam Bolts (A) and Wood Dowels (C).

Tighten by rotating Cam Locks **(B)** clockwise with Phillips screwdriver.


Insert Cam Locks (B) into holes on Side Panels (3/4) and Divider Panels (5/6).

Attach Bottom Panel (2) to Side Panels (3/4) and Divider Panels (5/6) using Cam Bolts (A) and Wood Dowels (C).

Tighten by rotating cam locks **(B)** clockwise with Phillips screwdriver.

Cover cam lock holes with Covers (V).




Insert Cam Locks **(B)** into holes on top side of Side Panels **(3/4)** and Divider Panels **(5/6)**.

Attach Top Panel (1) to Side Panels (3/4) and Divider Panel (5/6) using Wood Dowels (C) and Cam Bolts (A).

Tighten by rotating Cam Locks (B) clockwise with Phillips screwdriver.


Cover cam lock holes with Covers (V).



Attach Legs (21) to assembled unit with Bolts (D), Flat Washers (F), and Spring Washers (E).

Tighten all bolts with Allen Wrench (G).


Screw Adjustable Foot (17) into bottom of unit and tighten by hand.



Attach Back Panels (19/18/20) to back of assembled unit in same sequence as shown with Screws (P).


Tighten screws with Phillips screwdriver.

Insert Shelf Pins **(O)** into corresponding holes on unit.

Place Adjustable Shelves (10/11) onto Shelf Pins (0).



Connect Magnet (M) on underside of Top Panel (1) using Screws (P).


Attach Hinges (H) to Door Panel (8) with Screws (I).

Attach door to unit using attached Hinges (H) and Screws (I).

Attach Metal Plate (N) to door with Screw (I).

Attach Knob **(K)** onto Door Panel **(8)** with Bolt **(L)**.

Tighten bolt and screws with Phillips screwdriver.




Using Screws (P) connect Magnet (M) to underside of Top Panel (1).

Use Hinges (H) and Screws (I) to attach Glass Door Panel (9) to unit.

Attach Metal Plate **(N)** onto inside of door panel with Screw **(I)**.

Attach Knob **(K)** to Door Panel **(9)** with Bolt **(L)**.

Tighten bolts and screws with Phillips screwdriver.



Use Long Screws (J) to connect Drawer Left/Right Side Panels (13/14) to Drawer Back Panel (16).

Slide Drawer Bottom Panel (15) into corresponding grooves on drawer side and back panels.


Attach Drawer Front Panel (12-1) to assembled drawer using Long Screws (J).

Attach Knob **(K)** onto drawer front with Bolt **(L)**.


Tighten screws and bolts with Phillips screwdriver.

Repeat steps to assemble two other drawers using Drawer Front Panels (12-2) and (12-3).



Insert Drawers into glides on assembled unit.



If drawer hits adjoining parts or if drawer gap is not consistent, you can loosen screws on side and adjust drawer.




Attach Brackets (U) to Back Panel using Screws (R).

Tighten Screws (R) using a Philips screwdriver.

Mark two desired locations on wall. Drill two 3/16" holes on wall. Insert Plastic Anchors (Q) into holes on wall (use a hammer to help).

Attach Brackets (U) to wall using Screws (S).

Tighten Screws **(S)** using a Philips screwdriver.
