GALLEY RAIL



GALLEY RAIL IS 3/4" W X 4' L

Galley Rail is decorative trim ideal for dressing up shelves and cabinets. Use with Corner and End Posts to eliminate difficult miter cuts. Each piece of galley rail is sanded and ready for finishing.

STEP 1: CUT RAILS

Top and bottom rails are "press fit" on spindles so you can disassemble and finish the spindles in accent colors if desired. Cut top and bottom rails, using a mitre box and fine tooth saw if possible. For a mitred 90 deg. corner, cut 45 deg. angle.

STEP 2: GLUE AND CLAMP

Spindles may be left "press fit" in railings or you may choose to glue them or nail in place with brads. Some customers have used 1/4 inch dowels to secure the bottom rail to cabinets and shelves. You may find this helpful. When gluing to shelf, use "C" clamps to hold the parts together until dry.

STEP 3: FINISH TO SUIT

All parts are precision-machined, ready for finishing. Inspect and sand off any smeared glue before staining. Stain or paint.
