




#8 x 2" Pan Head Screws



1. Recess Mounting the Cabinet into the Wall

NOTE: The Remodeler cabinet was designed for either left or right-hand door swing. Turn the cabinet to your door swing preference during recess mounting.


- \square Complete the roughing-in as illustrated. The opening should be 14" (35.6 cm) x 18" (45.8 cm) and fall between two 16" (40.6 cm) on-center studs. Frame out the opening if the cabinet will not fall between two studs.
- ☐ Place the cabinet into the wall cutout and mount to the framing with the four provided mounting screws (see illustration for mounting hole locations). Use a level to assure the cabinet is level and plumb.
- ☐ Once the cabinet is mounted, use the four provided head caps to press onto the mounting screw heads.



2. Readjust Hinges (If Necessary)

NOTE: The Remodeler cabinet was factory-installed for correct closing. If the cabinet door is not level and plumb, follow these instructions.

- ☐ Loosen the two screws that fasten the door hinges to the cabinet slightly (labeled A in the illustration above). Adjust the cabinet door up or down until the top and bottom of the door closes within the cabinet recess. Tighten the two screws when the door is adjusted.
- ☐ If the door does not close correctly on either side, loosen the door mounting screws slightly (labeled B in the illustration above) to adjust the door from side-to-side. Tighten the screws when the door is adjusted.



☐ Use the provided hole plugs to cover any unused holes.
