

DURA-GATE INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you for purchasing Dura-Gate™ . . . fence gates durable for life. Get ready to experience life with no more irritating dragging, sagging or warping gates!

To install your Dura-Gate™, follow the instructions below. If you have any questions, you may view the Installation Video that is available at our web site, www.Dura-Gate.com. Or, feel free to contact us via the phone numbers listed above or by email at info@dura-gate.com.

Tools required for installation:

- Cordless drill with ½", 7/16", 3/8" sockets
- 3/16" Drill bit (per drill all wood screws)
- Skill Saw

Instructions:

Step 1)
Take down and properly dispose of the old gate.



Step 2)
Unpack your Dura-Gate™ frame, hinges, latch assembly, screws.



Step 3)
Depending upon the size Dura-Gate™ you purchased, you may have to install the horizontal rail using the screws provided.



Step 4)
Now, take a moment to accurately measure the gate opening.



Step 5)
Adjust the Dura-Gate™ to 1-1/4" to 1-1/2" smaller than opening width and allow an equal distance vertically from the top and bottom of the post. *



Step 6)
Now screw the frame into place.



* NOTE: Make sure you allow for any change from top to bottom by adjusting the gate frame itself.

Step 7)

Screw the first Wood, Composite or Vinyl board on the hinge side of the frame – Make sure gate board is the same height as the existing fence boards.



Step 8)

Screw the hinges through the first board onto the Dura-Gate™ frame. (Be sure that the top hinge lines up with the top horizontal rail and the bottom hinge lines up with bottom horizontal rail.)



Step 9)

Mount the frame to the fence at desired height.



Step 10)

Adjust the hinge alignment bolts to make the gaps at the hinge side and latch side match.



Step 11)

Attach the gate brace diagonally to the vertical uprights on frame.



Step 12)

Attach next board on the latch side of the frame.



Step 13)

Install the latch, striker bar, and handle to the post and gate at desired height. Then, install the remaining gate boards. *



Step 14)

Make any necessary tension and/or alignment adjustments to the hinges.



Step 15)

Congratulations! Now you have a perfectly smooth operating, super strong Dura-Gate™ fence gate!



* NOTE: You can tie a string across boards and use it as a guide to keep the boards straight and level.
