IMPORTANT INFORMATION

All you need to assemble THE EFFORT-LESS BIRDFEEDER is one flat tip or Phillips head screwdriver. In the event you need some personal guidance, simply call us at **877-493-8323** or visit us at **www.effortlessbirdfeeder.com**.



PLACEMENT OF THE EFFORT-LESS BIRDFEEDER IS IMPORTANT!

First, it is important to place the feeder in a location where you can see and enjoy the numerous wild birds that are attracted to the feeder.

NOTE:

Locate the feeder at least four feet from any window to help prevent birds from accidentally flying into glass.



Second, it is important to select or prepare a **LEVEL AND FLAT SURFACE** to keep THE EFFORT-LESS BIRDFEEDER stable and straight — decks and patios are ideal.



Third, select a location that is 7-10 feet away from "jump off points" for squirrels.

NOTE:

The Base of THE EFFORT-LESS BIRDFEEDER has been designed to hold up to 25 lbs. of dry sand. WE DO NOT RECOMMEND USING WATER TO FILL THE BASE. When the Base is on a LEVEL AND FLAT SURFACE, it is designed to hold THE EFFORT-LESS BIRDFEEDER stable and straight. If weather reports forecast excessive winds and/or gusts, we recommend that the top section of the feeder be lifted off the Middle Pole Section and stored in a safe place.







Turn Base (2) on its side and insert Pole Socket (3) into hole. Screw Pole Socket (3) securely into Base Nut (1) until tight.







Insert Lower Pole Section (4) into Pole Socket (3) and line up screw holes. Insert Carriage Bolt (14) through hole (side with square) in Pole Socket (3) until it comes out other side. Place Flat Washer (16) on end of Carriage Bolt (14) and secure tightly with Wing Nut (15). Place completed lower base assembly at desired feeding location MAKING **SURE YOU HAVE SELECTED A** LEVEL AND FLAT SURFACE. Lift off fill cap, and gradually begin filling the Base (2) with dry sand shaking occasionally to distribute sand evenly. When Base (2) is filled, replace cap securely.


Make sure you have selected a level and flat surface before you fill the base with sand.









Threaded parts are designed to thread together smoothly. If you experience tightness while threading, unscrew and re-assemble.














USE AND CARE

HOW TO FILL THE EFFORT-LESS BIRDFEEDER

To lower the feeder to the "filling position," hold on to the Grip, pull out the Safety Pin and simply lower the feeder to the Stop Flange on the Lower Pole Section. Now you can effortlessly fill your feeder.

To return the feeder to the "feeding position," grip below the Feed Tray and raise the feeder back up the pole. INSERT SAFETY PIN.



NOTE:

Safety Pin must be properly inserted to safely hold the feeder in the up position.

HOW TO EMPTY THE EFFORT-LESS BIRDFEEDER

In the unlikely event you need to empty bird seed from the Feed Tube, follow this procedure:

1. While depressing the Spring Button that joins the Middle Pole Section, rotate the Upper Pole Section until the Button "disappears" from view.





2. Hold on to the Grip, pull out the Safety Pin and lower the Birdfeeder Assembly to the Stop Flange.

3. Remove the Roof/Upper Pole Section Assembly and set it aside. You can now lift off the Birdfeeder Assembly and pour out the unwanted seed.



4. To re-assemble THE EFFORT-LESS BIRDFEEDER, follow steps 11,12 and 14 in the Assembly Instructions section.

HOW TO CARE FOR THE EFFORT-LESS BIRDFEEDER

To help prevent the spread of disease, a thorough cleaning of THE EFFORT-LESS BIRDFEEDER (or any feeder) should be performed as needed. To clean, lower THE EFFORT-LESS BIRDFEEDER to the filling position. Take a garden hose and flush out any remaining seed and debris from the Feed Tube and Feed Tray. Make sure all drainage holes in the Feed Tray are cleared. Now, using a long-handled bottle brush, together with a dish detergent solution (2 quarts water to 1 tablespoon detergent), scrub the inside & outside of the Feed Tube and the Feed Tray. Using a scrub brush, scrub the Squirrel Guard and Base and any other components that may require cleaning. Rinse all components thoroughly.

MAKE SURE INSIDE OF FEED TUBE IS THOROUGHLY DRY BEFORE REFILLING SEED.

NOTE:

Wild birds are certainly not the most tidy eaters. As a result, bird seed is always distributed on the ground around the feeder. If the bird seed remains on the ground for a long period of time and becomes wet, it will become unhealthy for the birds to eat. Therefore, it is advisable to sweep up this seed and discard.

The pole sections of THE EFFORT-LESS BIRDFEEDER are powder coated to resist rust and deterioration. It is a good idea, however, to further protect the pole sections with a periodic coating of silicone lube spray paying particular attention to where the pole sections join together.



FIVE YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY

The following Limited Warranty is made solely for the benefit of the original purchaser, who must be a consumer, of The EFFORT-LESS BIRD FEEDER (the "Product"), manufactured by Zenith Innovation, LLC ("Zenith"). Such original purchaser is referred to herein as "You."

Subject to the terms and conditions of this Limited Warranty, Zenith warrants to You for a period of five (5) years from the date of purchase, that the Product will be free from defects in materials and workmanship ("Covered Defects"). This Limited Warranty shall not apply to defects other than Covered Defects, defects caused by acts of God or other problems in the Product including, without limitation: (i) defects caused by the failure to use a Product in accordance with Zenith's instructions or manuals; (ii) defects caused by modifications or repairs to the Product other than by Zenith; and (iii) defects caused by misuse, abuse or neglect of the Product. In order for this Limited Warranty to be effective, You must complete and deliver to Zenith a completed Warranty Registration Form within thirty (30) days of your purchase of the Product, and must notify Zenith in writing of the nature of any defect within thirty (30) days of your discovery of the defect.

If Zenith determines that a defect in the Product is a Covered Defect covered by this Limited Warranty, it shall repair or replace the Product as it deems appropriate, and shall be responsible for all costs incurred by it in connection with the repair or replacement (as applicable) of the Product.
