TILE PROJECTS

KNOW-HOW

- The Tiling 1-2-3 book is a great resource for a tile project
- Always purchase 10-15% extra tile to make sure you have enough of the correct dye lot to complete the job
- Make sure your floor is flat, level and rigid
- Make sure the floor is clean. Dust, oil, wax or grease will prevent the adhesive from working properly
- To improve appearance, plan your layout in a way that you start with whole tiles working from the center outwards.

 This means any cut tiles will be at the wall edges
- Test the first tile to make sure you are getting complete thinset coverage on the back of the tile
- Spacers will help create straight, professional grout lines
- Apply sealer after grout has cured a minimum of 3 days
