

HOW TO MAKE A ORNAMENT TREE



SKILL LEVEL: ADVANCED
TIME: 3 HOURS

YOU WILL NEED:

- **MARTHA STEWART LIVING™**
SNOWBERRY BIRD ORNAMENTS

SNOWBERRY WIRE-EDGED RIBBON

- **6 BRANCHES (1IN–1¼IN DIAMETER, 6",**
12", 18", 24", 30", 36")
- **HAND SAW**
- **DRILL WITH 1/4-INCH BIT**
- **BRASS WIRE**
- **WALL HANGER**



STEP 1

Cut branches into pieces from small to large, and all 6 inches apart in size, starting with a 6in branch at the top and a 36in branch at the bottom. This will form a tree in a uniform triangle shape.



STEP 2

Using a 1/4in drill bit, drill a hole in each end of each branch, about 1.5" from the edge. Drill on the diagonal so that ribbon threaded through the holes will be straight.



STEP 3

Cut a piece of ribbon long enough to create both sides of your tree, with some extra length for knotting. Twist one end and thread through the holes on one side, from the smallest branch to the largest.

Note: Tie a knot below each branch to prevent the wood from slipping on the ribbon. Repeat with the other end of ribbon down the opposite side of the tree.



STEP 4

Be sure to leave some extra ribbon at the top for hanging.



STEP 5

To decorate, thread brass wire through ornament top and wrap around branch. Hang ball or icon ornaments with brass wire.

Drill small holes in branch and insert twigs to attach clip-on ornaments.



STEP 6

Hang on the wall with a bracket and enjoy a festive display.
