HANGING ORNAMENTS IN WINDOWS

- Martha Stewart
 Living Merry Metallic
 oversized ornaments
 (72 ct.)
- Martha Stewart Living Merry Metallic 5"

- Christmas ornaments with pattern (9 ct.)
- Martha Stewart Living Merry Metallic wire edged ribbon
- 28-gauge steel galvanized wire
- Wire cutters
- Command[™] hooks
- Scissors

HANGING ORNAMENTS IN WINDOWS





STEP 1

Thread ribbon through one large ornament. Position the ornament at center so that ribbon length is even on both sides. Hold the ornament and ribbon from the top of your window so you can determine at what height you want the ornament to hang. Cut the ribbon to the determined length. Let the ornament hang at center and flatten out the ribbon's wire edges so it lies as flat as possible.



STEP 2

Gather ribbon ends together. Fold a 10-inch piece of 28-gauge wire in half. Twist to create a loop.



STEP 3

Wrap ends around ribbon tightly.

STEP 4

Cut a 6-inch piece of wire. Fold it in half and feed through the center of the snowflake. Twist wire together a few times on back of the snowflake, creating a loop to secure the wire in place.



STEP 5

Position a Command hook on the window molding and hook wire to hang the ornament, then hang snowflake on the same Command hook.



STEP 6

Space ornaments evenly in window frame at a variety of lengths.
