MATERIALS

- White canvas painter's tarp
- Grommets
- Bungee cords
- River rocks
- Projector (301934)

TOOLS

- Grommet punc
- Ladder

SKILL LEVEL

Beginner

Punch grommets into three sides of tarp, spaced every 18 inches or so. Leave bottom side grommet-free.

Feed bungee cords through grommets and secure screen to pergola or porch frame,

stretching as smoothly as possible, letting it hang with 2 to 3 inches of extra canvas pooling on ground.


Arrange decorative river rocks across extra groundlevel canvas, to weight tarp down. Set up projector following package directions, on sturdy side table or other base. Wait until dark, bring out popcorn and enjoy.
