PERSONALIZE YOUR MESSAGES ON A DIY CHALKBOARD

Your message can change on a whim when you create this DIY chalkboard space. Use a piece of masonite board or picture frame and chalkboard spray paint to display your personal messages. Make it as small or large as you'd like!







ITEMS

- One ¼ inch sheet 4x8 masonite board or picture frame
- Painter's Touch 2X Ultra Cover Primer in White
- Specialty Chalk Board Spray Paint
- · Colored Chalk Board Chalk
- #120-grit sandpaper

- Drop cloth
- Tack cloth
- Mask
- Latex gloves
- · Comfort Grip Nozzle (optional)

Step 1: Lightly sand surface with #120 grit sandpaper.

Step 2: Use a tack cloth to wipe away sanding residue.

Step 3: Spray primer 10-16 inches away in slow, even coats using a steady back-and-forth motion. Let primer dry for approximately 20 minutes.

Step 4: Apply 2 or more coats of chalk board spray paint the same way as the primer, using steady back-and-forth motions for best coverage.

Step 5: Let the first coat of paint dry and apply a second coat within the hour, or after 48 hours.

Step 6: Surface will be dry to the touch after 20 minutes and fully cured after 24 hours.

Step 7: Rub chalk over the entire surface of chalk board paint and erase to prime the surface for writing.

Tip: To add additional flair to your chalkboard, mount it inside a frame coated with one of the many Rust-Oleum Metallic Spray Paints available.
