ITEMS

- One Case of "Ball" Jars
- Painter's Touch 2X Ultra Cover White Primer
- Painter's Touch 2X Ultra Cover Spray Paint
- Specialty Clear Chalk Board Spray Paint
- Chalk Marker
- Sandpaper

- Drop Cloth
- Lint Free Cloth
- Glass Cleaner
- Mask
- Latex Gloves
- Comfort Grip Nozzle (Optional)
- **Step 1:** Clean each jar with glass cleaner and thoroughly dry.
- **Step 2:** Lightly sand each jar for better paint adhesion and wipe with a lint-free cloth.
- **Step 3:** Over a drop cloth, spray primer on each jar holding it 10-16 inches away. Spray in slow, even coats using a steady back-and-forth motion. Let primer dry for approximately 20 minutes.
- **Step 4:** Apply 1-2 coats of spray paint the same way as the primer, using steady back-and-forth motions for best coverage.
- **Step 5:** Let the first coat of paint dry and apply a second coat within the hour, or after 48 hours.
- **Step 6:** Spray the Clear Chalk Board paint in the same way, applying 2 or more light coats letting each coat dry for at least 20 minutes. Allow 24 hours to fully dry.
- **Step 7:** Rub chalk over the surface of the chalk board paint and erase to prime the surface for writing.
- **Step 8:** Using a Chalk Board Marker, draw designs onto each jar and let dry for about 20 minutes before handling.
- **Tip:** Allow paint to fully cure for approximately 24 hours before use.
